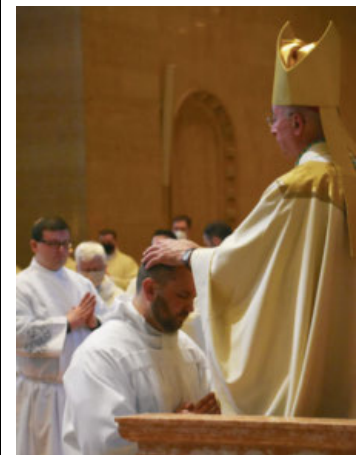

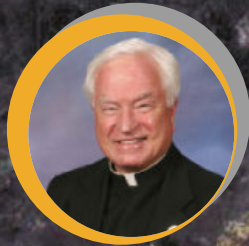

REFLECTION & SCRIPTURE READINGS

The Sacraments are outward signs of an invisible reality. We are body-soul composites; so that change interiorly is important, but so too are the symbols that help us to understand or receive that change. In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the dove often can refer us to the presence of the Spirit (bringing us back to the Baptism of Jesus), the flame to the gifts and fruits received as our relationship with and through the Holy Spirit is strengthened.



OUR ADVOCATE - THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH

The Sacrament of Confirmation is an affirmation of our Baptism. It is our opportunity to say “yes, I do understand my baptism and I believe that the Holy Spirit is with me always.” It also is our chance to say “I want to be part of Christ’s church and I want the courage to practice my faith and take the next step toward a life filled with joy in the hopes of achieving eternal life.”

With this Sacrament you are sealed with the Holy Spirit just as the Apostles were on Pentecost. With the Holy Spirit come seven gifts and twelve fruits that if used appropriately will bring joy to you and to all those you interact with daily. Imagine someone describing you and using adjectives such as loving, peaceful, patient, kind, gentle, faithful, or modest. Those are just some of the fruits of the Holy Spirit and can be a big part of who you are.

The world teaches us to always want more accomplishments and earthly achievements. Jesus teaches us to always love more. The earlier you can understand this, the more you will experience the true joy of life. God created us in His own image in order to live our lives in a way that helps others get to heaven, thereby, gaining the reward of eternal life ourselves.

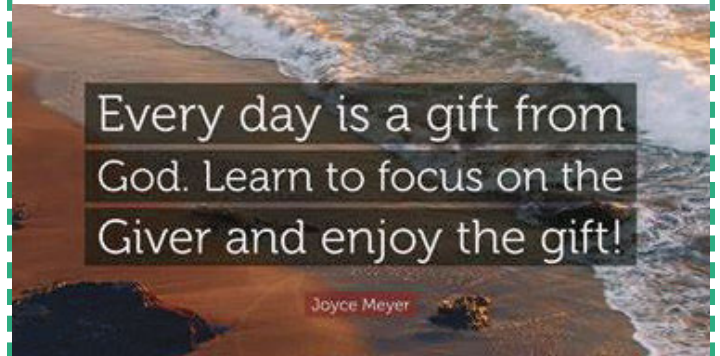
The Holy Spirit guides us every day and will be with us always. Recognize that and you will achieve whatever it is that God wants you to if you use these gifts daily. The Sacrament of Confirmation prepares you for the rest of your life. Believe and trust in God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. I encourage you to turn to these gifts and fruits in your times of struggle or need. Pray for any of the specific gifts or fruits you are yearning for or add to your daily routine a prayer for all of the gifts and/or all of these fruits. Jesus promises that you will be rewarded.

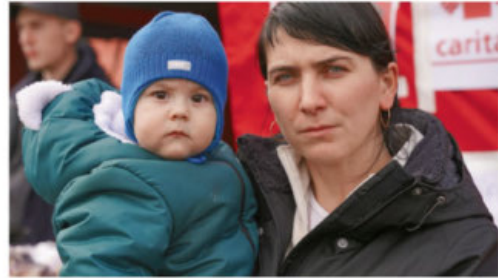
