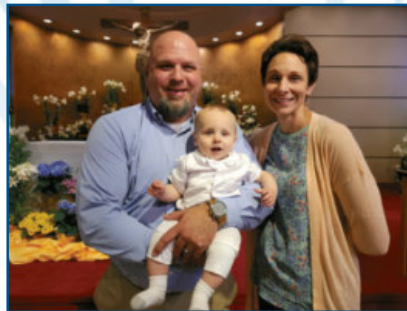

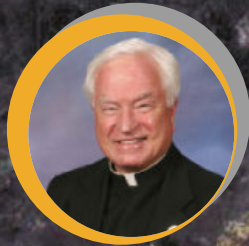


Memorial Day Prayer

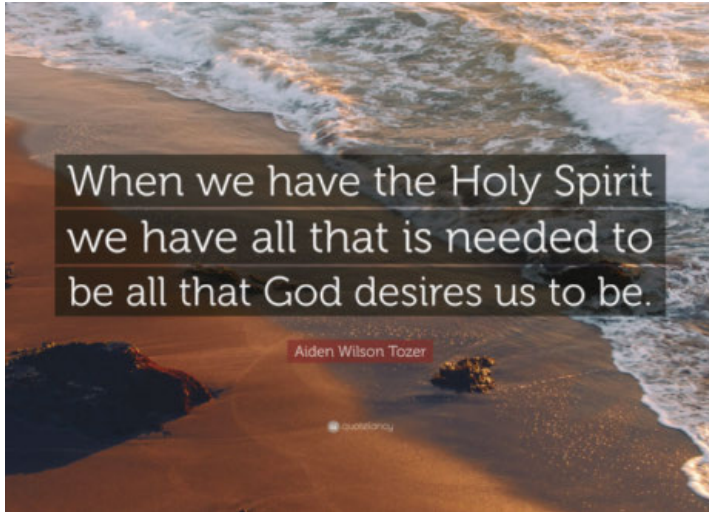

REFLECTION & SCRIPTURE READINGS

May we never forget that in our Baptism we have received the gift of the Holy Spirit in its entirety and then are given the Sacraments and prayer as means to continue to foster a deeper relationship with Love Himself. Friends, do not be afraid to ask for an increase of the Holy Spirit and to be consciously aware that He is teaching through the ordinary of our days.



COME HOLY SPIRIT

Why do we pray, “Come, Holy Spirit?” Isn’t the Holy Spirit with us already? I hear questions like these from our teens all the time. They have a low tolerance for apparent contradictions, and I love that.

Here’s the TLDR: We all should want to be like Mary.

When we are Baptized we become “an adoptive son of the Father, a member of Christ, and a temple of the Holy Spirit.” (CCC 1279) This indwelling of the Holy Spirit is a character of the Baptized person that continues as long as we are in the state of grace: a condition of the soul where you have no stain of serious (mortal) sin which can be restored through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Luke gives us a beautiful example of the indwelling of grace and the Holy Spirit. When the Angel Gabriel appears to Mary, he calls her by a specific title. The Greek puts multiple words together to form this title: kecharitomene, which can be translated “full of grace.” Mary was not just in the state of grace. She was filled with it. So much so that when the angel explains “the holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you.” (Luke 1:35) she literally bears in her womb God incarnate. So even if we are in the state of grace, I think we would be reaching to say we are full of grace.

That is exactly what the prayer “Come, Holy Spirit” is striving for. That we would be so filled with the life of God and so animated by Him that we would be able to bear Christ with us and present Him to the world. This Pentecost, let us invite the Spirit to fill us to overflow. Come Holy Spirit!



15 minutes each day spent in God’s presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!



Reflection questions for Sunday, June 5th

- On Pentecost Sunday, the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and gave them the gift of speaking in multiple languages of the mighty acts of God accomplished in Jesus Christ. What gifts of the Spirit might you pray for today?
- Paul speaks of believers in Christ as having the “Spirit of God” dwelling within them. How do you experience the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life?
- The resurrected Jesus breathed on the disciples and gave the Holy Spirit to them to forgive or retain sins. How often do you partake in the Sacrament of Reconciliation?

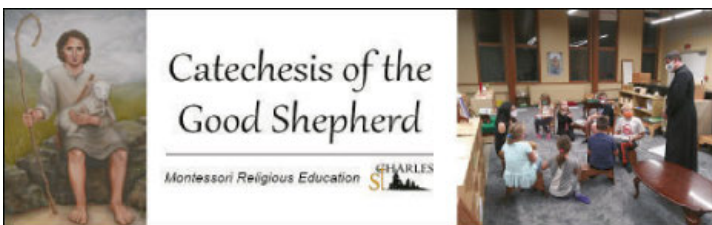
CARD DRIVE FOR PRISONERS
