ALWAYS FORWARD

Kathleen Wartman

My name is Kathleen Wartman, and I'm one of the volunteer youth ministers with EDGE at St. Charles. During my time as a youth minister, I've had this burning desire to learn how we can become better witnesses in our faith for our teens. The Holy Spirit answered this desire of mine when I received a phone call from Rachel Heffron, who is one of our ministry co-leads. She invited me to the Catholic Youth Ministry Convention in Scottsdale, Arizona earlier this June, and I knew I had to go as soon as she asked me. It was at this convention where the Lord exposed to me how relational ministry is foundational to sustainable youth ministry. We need to meet our teenagers where they're at and model the unconditional love that Jesus has for them so that they can experience His grace in action. The most pertinent message the Lord presented me with was this: "You are not the sum of your past, but rather, you're the sum of the unconditional love I have for you. Seek me, and you will find your identity." It is our desire as youth ministers to help your teen find their identity in Christ. To do so, we must demonstrate the perseverance of a broken yet convicted soul who continually shows up every day simply because Christ is worth it.

- In the parable of the good Samaritan, Jesus taught the scribe the importance of showing mercy toward one's neighbor as central to following God's law. How well do you practice the virtue of mercy?

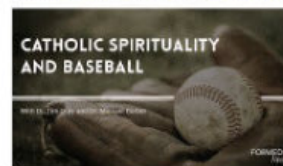
JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT
