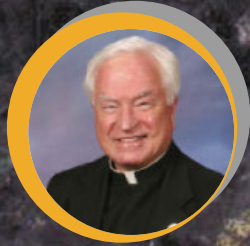

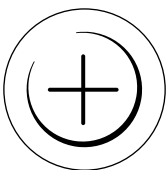

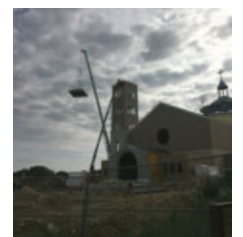

CORNERSTONE UPDATE - BELLS WILL BE RINGING!

Parishioners gathered around Fr. Ken and Fr. Ariel as they blessed the bells of the new church after the 9 a.m. Mass on July 3. Shortly after daybreak on July 7, the bells were lifted up and placed in the steeple. After placement of the bells, the steeple was capped. On top of the cap is a smaller version of the larger cross on the dome. Seen here, construction workers line up on the entrance roof to begin work. On the east side, framing continues on the chapel, exterior scaffolding was built to provide access to the rotunda and steeple, and the north east parking lot was milled and will be graded for new pavement.

All this activity puts us so close to the finish line. Fr. Ken recently sent a letter to all parishioners asking for prayerful consideration of a gift to the Cornerstone Campaign to help get us across the finish line. 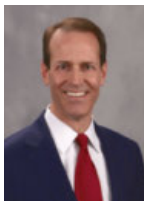

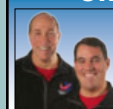
