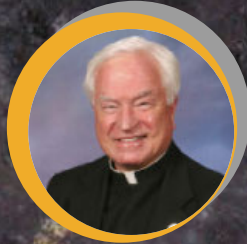

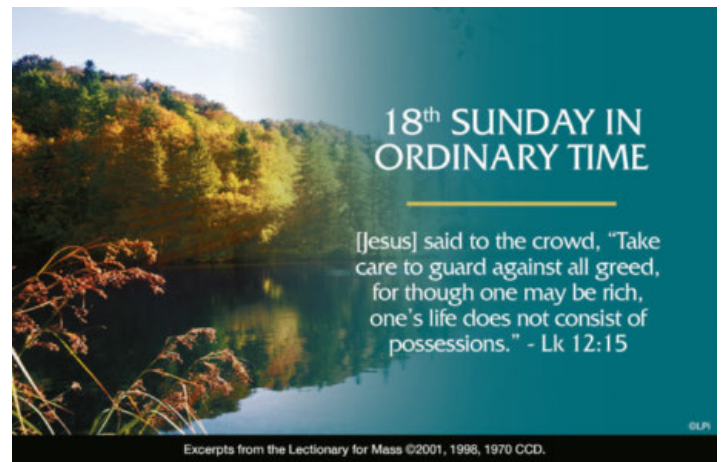

## LETTING GOD IN!

I recently went on the Love Begins Here (LBH) mission trip in Beaver Dam, a 5-day trip offered through the Archdiocese that really changed my life. Before going on this trip, I had never really been close with God or cared about my faith. On the first day, all I wanted to do was leave. On that same day, I also met my "roommates" for the week. They were from St. Jerome in Oconomowoc; a woman named Brianna had heard me complaining about being there. She said, "the Lord has many great things planned for you this week." Of course, I didn't believe her because I just met her, and I was only there for confirmation hours (so I thought). As the week continued, I realized truly how beautiful it was to have a connection with God. When I met my car group for the first time, everything was so awkward. Toward the end of the first day, we had become close friends, and each day we connected more through our work and, as funny as it sounds, by sitting in the car with each other on the way to each destination.

On Wednesday, we had confession and adoration. I feel like this time I confessed my sins, I said everything I needed to say because I wanted to be honest with God. I cried through my whole confession, but right when I walked out that door, I instantly felt a feeling of refreshment. I walked back into the church, kneeled down, prayed, and looked at God. This was the moment I felt God there with me. It felt like he was sitting next to me, and I felt safe where I was. I never thought I would be moved to tears during an adoration, but this time it was different. This time I saw God. This time I felt God. This time I opened my heart to God. And this time I told myself it was time. It was time to grow in my faith and become closer to God.

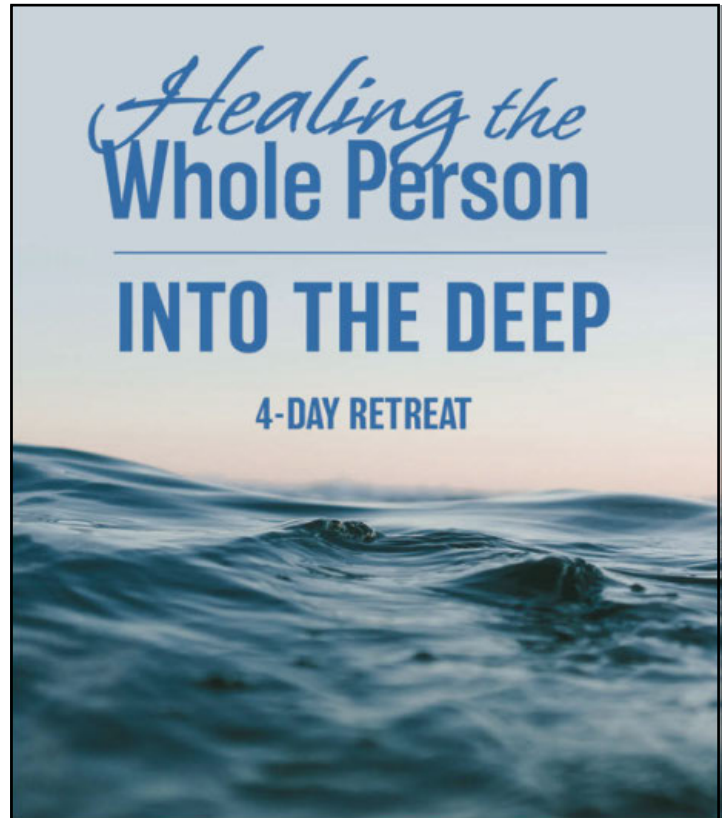

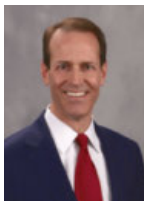

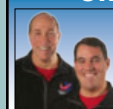
