Trust God and Believe
in good things to come!

In the Gospel (John 4: 43-54) reading for Monday, March 28, we meet a royal official whose son is ill in Capernaum. He implores Jesus to come heal his son, but Jesus has other plans for him.

***“Jesus said to him, ‘You may go; your son will live.’
The man believed what Jesus said to him and left.”
(John 4:50)***

The stories of Jesus’ good works preceded him in Galilee, and this father sought Him out to save his son. He not only trusted what he had heard previously but also went on to trust Jesus’ word. This was certainly a risk, but he believed.

I think we sometimes struggle with seeing the signs right in front of us and believing that there is a greater purpose for everything that happens in our lives. We can get distracted by trivial things or get bogged down by all of the things happening around us. It can also be easy to experience feelings of doubt. What this Gospel reading tells us is to trust and believe, give up your doubts. How often do you question the signs you get in your daily life? How often do you believe that God is putting people, things, or events in your life for a good reason? Sometimes it’s easier said than done, but it’s important to be present, to take time out to see what God is putting before us. We must believe, just as this scared father did. Throughout this fourth week of Lent, I invite you to trust in what the Lord tells you!

Lectio Divina

READ:

- Pray the Gospel slowly for that day and invite God to speak to your heart.

REFLECT:

- Let God reveal a word or phrase that connects to you personally – ask questions to more deeply understand.

RESPOND:

- Thank the Lord for His generosity and *resolve to act* and *trust* according to how God led your prayer.

REST:

- Encounter God in the silence and *listen* to Him tell you how much He loves you!
