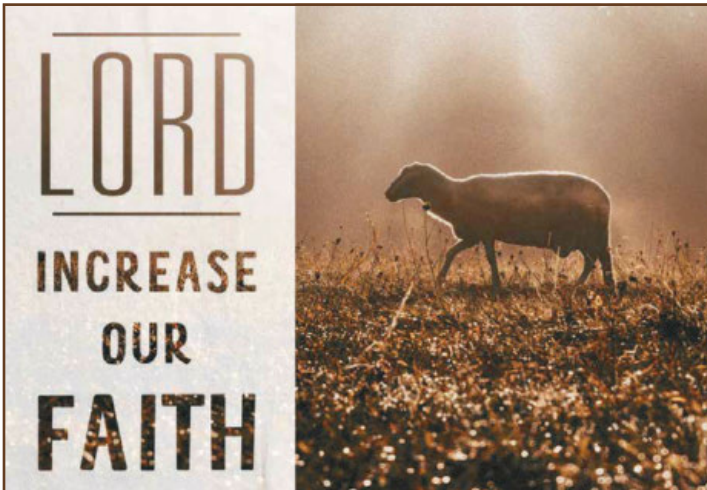

INCREASE OUR FAITH

I have frequently begged our Lord for the grace to receive the depth of faith I see in the Saints. God has always answered this intercession. Before you start claiming that this constancy of response from our Lord has not been your experience, let me clarify two points. First, most times, God responded in ways I neither intended, wanted, or liked – but I took comfort in the truth that Jesus heard the cry of His little one and responded. Second, the lives of the Saints are worthy of emulation, yet please don't forget that they too struggled as you and I, yet chose to persevere, chose virtue when sin would have been easier – and when they did not choose God, they turned back to Him, who was never far off.

The unexpected answer of God is always better than our desired outcome because the One who gave us the desire, and thereby will fulfill it, is doing just that. We are letting God be God and falling deeper in love with Him through a greater trust in His Providential Care. We begin to see through eyes of faith who God is for us and who we are for Him. We are His children, so we can approach Him in our neediness and poverty without guilt or shame. A child does not wonder if the action they are doing is right, they just do it. When they are hungry, hurt, sick, cranky, etc. they cry out to whoever will hear them and expect to be shown comfort, understanding, or healing for their pain, and they expect a resolution. This may come through some tough love, other times they may be held, other times they will have to endure the pain because that is the only way to get through the pain. We know this is not usually what we or they like, but God uses it all for His Glory, our sanctification!

As you embark on this week, sit with the Lord and let Him speak. By your presence before Him, you have responded to His call. Think about that: We often will say, 'I'm going to go pray.' There is truth in that statement that you have made a choice to pause during your day and pray. In reality, the deeper root is that God called you to that prayer moment, and through His Grace, you said yes. Lord, increase our faith!

15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

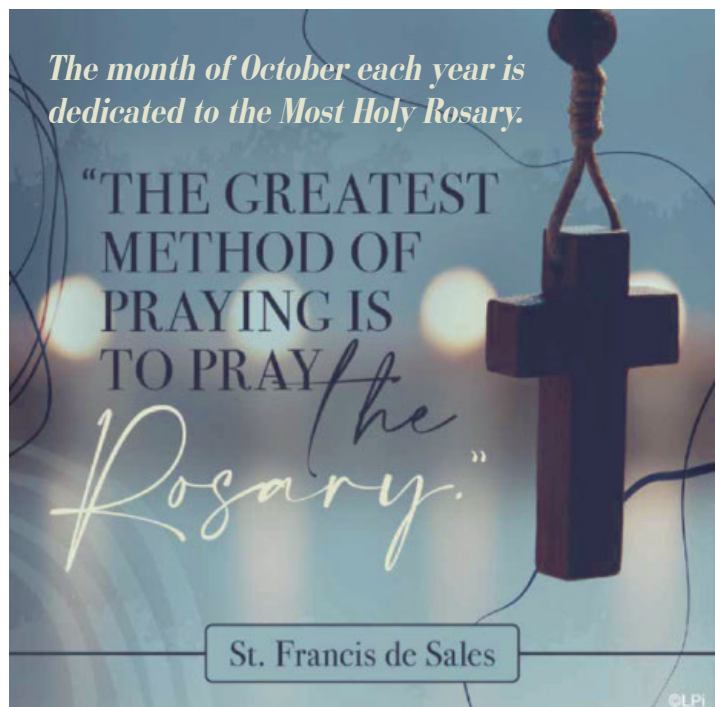
Reflection questions for Sunday, October 9th

BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU WISH FOR

You've probably heard the phrase "Be careful what you wish for." In my experience, it's not often utilized with a lot of charity. You usually hear it said as a warning. The unspoken sentiment behind it is this: You're not as strong as you think you are.

As Christians we shouldn't be surprised to look ourselves in the mirror and own that reality. We are not as strong as we may think. We are time and time again shocked and dismayed by our own weaknesses, our own fears, our own shortcomings.

Should we be careful what we wish for? The apostles asked Jesus to increase their faith, and He told them it would take work. It would take suffering. It would take patience. But He didn't say it was impossible.

As everyday stewards, we need to continue wishing recklessly. Ask God for anything and everything, come to Him with all your needs. Beg Him for grace without limit.



When we hear God's voice, it does not always say what we want to hear. But it always speaks the perfect truth. If it tells us of a hardship that we think we cannot bear, let us take solace in the knowledge that we are the stewards — not the landlord.

LIVE THE LITURGY
INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Why does God allow evil and suffering to occur? Looking around at what is happening in the world, it is tempting to get angry with God for not actively intervening. Jesus walked among the suffering and evil of His day. While He healed some things, He simply sat with the sinner, challenged the leaders, and spoke against injustice. Jesus spoke of God's kingdom and His vision for humanity. But He made it very clear that it is our responsibility to realize this vision. The disciples saw how Jesus lived and dealt with the day's circumstances. They wanted that same faith and determination. They wanted His fortitude and courage. Mostly, they wanted Jesus' confidence and patience that God's vision would someday be fulfilled. In the meantime, waiting in joyful hope, we become servants who do what is necessary: love, repent of our sin, show mercy, be compassionate and fight injustice. MASS FOR SISTER THEA BOWMAN

During October and November, we will be singing and praying with the "Mass for Sister Thea Bowman," which was written in honor of the late nun whose cause for canonization is currently underway. Sr. Thea was a nationally-known professor, preacher, singer, and evangelist until her death in 1990 at the age of 52. She joined the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration in La Crosse, WI as a teen and was the only African American woman to join that order. After taking vows, her religious order sent her on to earn master's and doctorate degrees in English literature and linguistics at Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.

Sister Thea taught in parochial schools and at Viterbo University. Her ministry grew and attracted national attention. Soon she was in demand to speak to congregations of all races, including the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

I am thrilled to share this music with St. Charles, and I hope that it inspires you to find out more about Sister Thea's legacy. 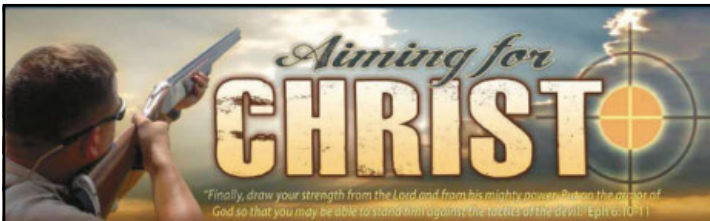

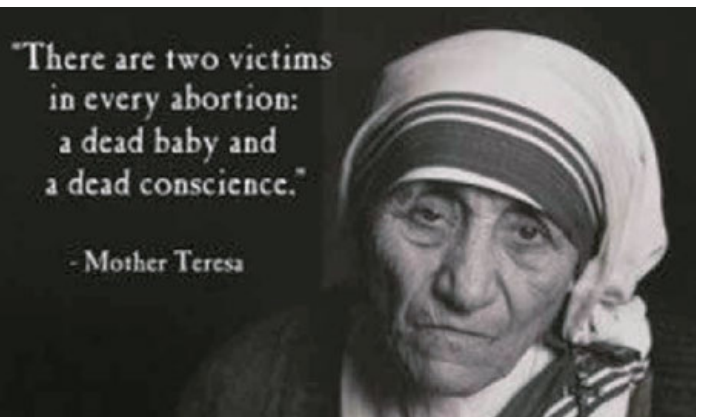


A JOURNEY OF FAITH AND ANTIQUITY TO GREECE
