## THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

### 4TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In my parents' bedroom there were on the wall two photos of my mom and dad from their early adulthoods. The photo of my mother entranced me when I was a boy. I loved looking at it, even though I saw her in daily life. Something about that picture captured her perfectly. It was an image of the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength that enveloped me from the start of my life. It was an icon of the woman who fed, taught, and encouraged me. I felt a deep pride that I came from such beauty.

The beatitudes of Jesus are a kind of self-portrait. But it is a strange picture. At first, the blessings of being poor, mourning, and hungering and thirsting for righteousness may seem bizarre or, worse, a religious delusion. Who wants to look like that? But if we look again, we begin to see the characteristics of Jesus' form. He becomes poor and fills it with his riches for us, he weeps and mourns for us and fills it with his joy, he hungers and thirsts for us to be righteous and so satisfies us. And so on. It's the way he appears on the cross.

Perhaps we should put on our bedroom walls the words of the beatitudes next to a crucifix of the Lord Jesus. Then we can do what the beatitudes are designed for, to gaze at the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength of the one who is our origin and who is with us every day. And little by little, we'll start to look like him.

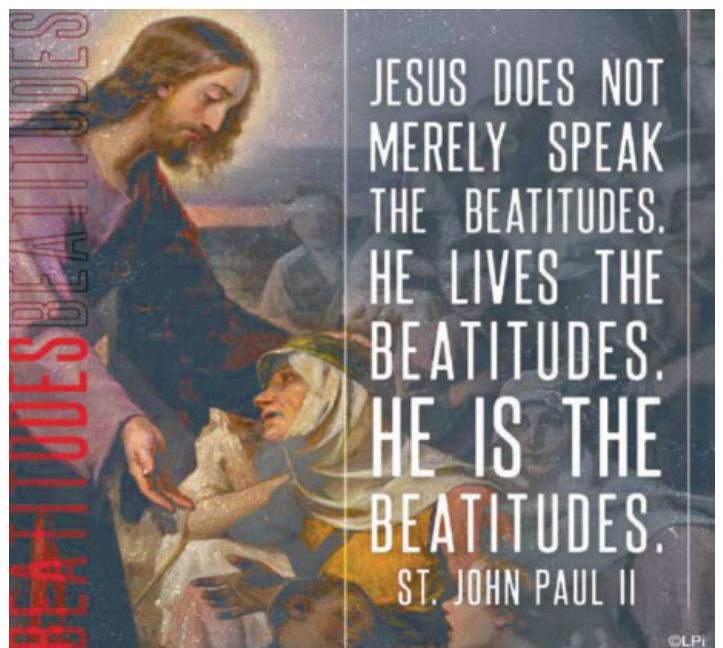
### Reflection questions for Sunday, February 5th

When I think of the Beatitudes, I think of collectible coffee mugs emblazoned with the words Blessed are the peacemakers, with little pastel flowers stenciled in the white spaces of the lettering. I think of greeting cards and decorative wall hangings.

Why? These are the Beatitudes, for heaven's sake — revolutionary and radical. An uncompromising impeachment of worldly values. They are the opposite of banal.

But I cringed from my head to my toes when I read my first draft of this reflection, a retelling of a time in my life when I decided to embrace humility and meekness. I realized that the Beatitudes aren't something I can tell you about. Poverty of spirit, the hunger for righteousness, the gladness God gives to the downtrodden — these are concepts that must be animated within us. They must be lived. So instead of telling you my story, I want you to tell yours.

I invite you to think of a time when you were vulnerable. When you were discouraged or humbled or felt like a failure. A time when you were cut low. The loss of a job, perhaps, or the rejection of a loved one. The abrupt end of some road that you felt sure would be long and prosperous.

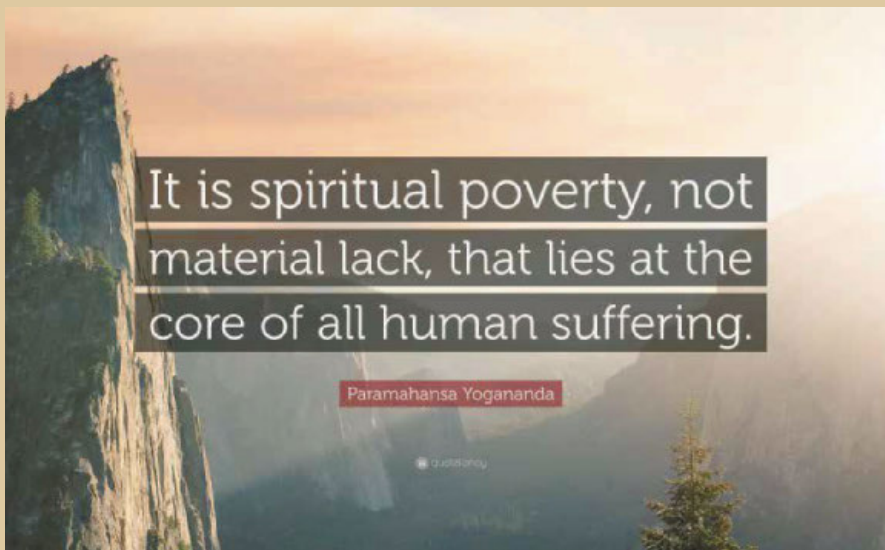
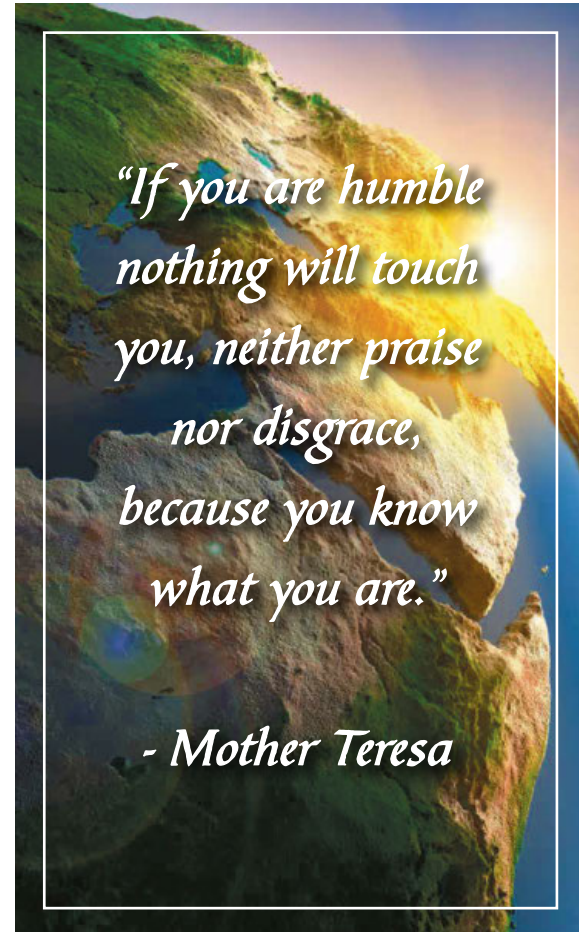
Resentment, envy, and vengefulness flourish in moments like this. Did you experience those feelings? Did you embrace them? Did you want to?

Specifically, these men and women break open the Word of God through Bible Studies, 1-on-1 coffee hang outs, and [maybe even most powerfully] through the witness they give by how they live and speak. Joe Heyrman, who calls St. Charles his home parish, shares a testimony with us of the impact Daniel is having through FOCUS' presence at Iowa State University, where Joe has been called to serve for the past two years.

"Selecting Iowa State has had a much bigger impact on my life than I ever imagined. Coming to school, I had a foundation of faith from my family but not one that was original to me. Joining a bible study in college has pushed me to become more involved and learn more and more about the depths of my Christian faith. While I ultimately had to make the choice to dive in, I was given a strong push by the FOCUS missionaries, specifically by my small group leader Joe, who made and continues to make countless invitations to me. He has also been here to answer countless questions I have about the faith.

The FOCUS missionaries have created a community that keeps people wanting to come back and grow in their faith. I recently attended their SEEK Conference with well over a hundred people from ISU and around 17,000 students overall. It was extremely inspiring. The amount of people there shows how exciting the faith is when we start to understand it more! The more I build on my foundation of faith, the more I get excited to continue to push it forward through a life of prayer and bring others along with me. The FOCUS team at Iowa State, specifically Joe, has changed my life in unimaginable ways, and I am forever grateful for that!"

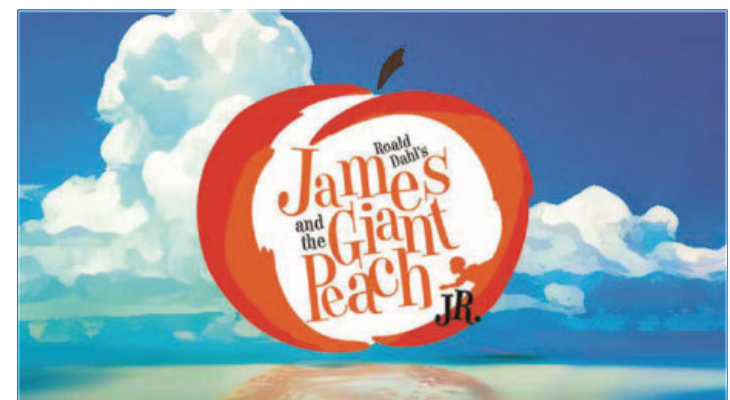

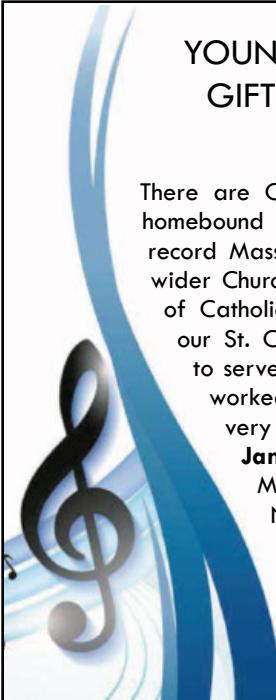


#### JAMES & THE GIANT PEACH AUDITIONS

## CANDLEMAS & ST. BLAISE BLESSING OF THE THROATS

### Candlemas – February 2

Part of the ancient tradition of the Church is to celebrate "Candlemas," which occurs on February 2nd, 40 days after Christmas. This day, also known as the Presentation of the Lord, commemorates Jesus being presented to God at the Temple 40 days after his birth, according to the Law of Moses. Christians consider Jesus to be the "light of the world;" this belief is reinforced by the proclamation of Simeon, who took the infant Jesus in his arms and proclaimed that the child would be "...a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." (Luke 2:32).
