**THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION**

**7TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME**

***“He pardons all your iniquities, heals all your ills...Not according to our sins does he deal with us...for the temple of God, which you are, is holy.”***

I find such comfort in this combination of quotes from the Psalms, 1st Corinthians, and Matthew’s Gospel. As we prepare to enter into the Lenten Season, we are hopefully reflecting on what we will offer for a fast, for our almsgiving, and for prayer. Holy Mother Church asks this of us, and St. Charles has a plethora of opportunities for you and your family to engage and encounter God in such ways. I want to invite you into a deepening perspective of faithfulness to the living of the Will of God daily.

God knows us. He created us. He loved us into existence. God sees us.

He knows those parts of our day, the circumstances we experience, and the people we meet that sometimes cause us to turn away from His Goodness and choose a lesser good. As baptized daughters and sons, we have the very Spirit of God present within us. Through the gift of the other Sacraments we receive, Grace is continually fostered to strengthen us to choose God. Sometimes we don’t; often we do. God uses it all.

To our wonder, He takes tragedy, and He redeems it. He takes suffering and restores it. He takes joy, and He upholds it. Will you come to the Lord this Lent as you never have before? We don’t have to earn anything by performing certain deeds or sacrificing the best right thing. He receives us today in our mess. He will receive us tomorrow in our order. He receives us everyday right where we are, and He names within us our identity – Himself – and He calls us deeper.

Be with the Lord this Lent, just as you are, and watch Him work miracles, watch Him heal, watch Him call you into love more profoundly and intimately!

**Lectio Divina**

15 minutes each day spent in God’s presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

**Reflection questions for Sunday, February 26th**

- Genesis teaches us that humanity’s first sin against God was that of disobedience — they listened to the voice of the snake (the devil) rather than God’s voice. What are some ways we can avoid the sin of disobedience in this first week of Lent?
- Paul teaches us that through Jesus’ obedience to his Father (as opposed to Adam’s “transgression”), believers receive the gift of God’s grace and “acquittal” from condemnation. How can we all be more mindful of this divine reversal of fortunes during Lent?
- Each year the Gospel reading for the season of Lent begins with the story of Jesus’ temptation in the desert by the devil. What temptations are you willing to confront during the forty days of Lent?

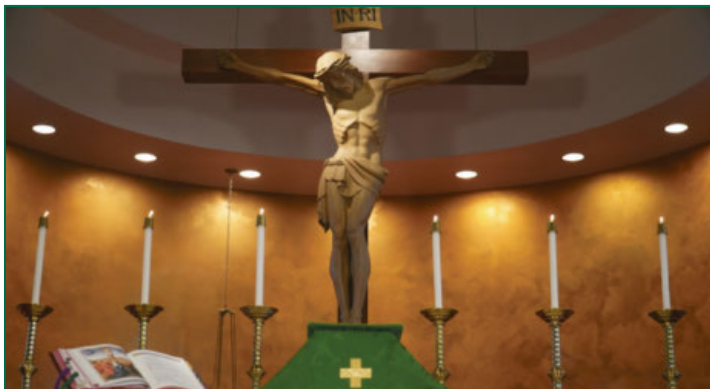

**THE HARDNESS OF HOLINESS**

Want to know the words I find hardest to say? "Lord, give me the strength."

The world tells us to push ourselves outside of our comfort zone if we're training for a marathon or applying for a job — but if we're talking about God, everything is supposed to be easy. If it comes "naturally" or without struggle, it's supposed to be right.

Only God is perfect, the world tells us. What's the use of trying so hard?

I'm really good at finding excuses for myself, especially when it comes to holiness. Holiness often (not always, but often) is about choosing the hard but right thing. The invitation to holiness is whispered in the hardest moments of my day when I am the most hopelessly human. After the kids' bedtime, when I really just want to watch Dateline and eat too much ice cream instead of saying the Rosary. When I've committed to helping someone, but it suddenly becomes incredibly inconvenient. When I see a social media post that's just begging for a snarky reply. When the conversation becomes gossip and I'm dying to make myself feel superior to someone.

The reason it's so difficult for me to mutter these five simple words is because I know that if I say them and I mean them, they form a prayer that God will always answer in the affirmative. He will give me the strength I ask for, and then I will have no excuse.

It's not unlike my kids claiming they're too tired to clean up the playroom. If they would just ask me for help, it would all be so doable. But where would that leave them?

With a job to do, that's where.

## ASH WEDNESDAY AT ST. CHARLES

Ash Wednesday is celebrated on February 22 this year, and it marks the beginning of Lent. Here at St. Charles, we will celebrate Masses at 6:30 am, 8:30 am, Noon, and 6:00 pm. Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of obligation, but those attending Mass will have the opportunity to receive ashes on their forehead. The ashes come from the burning of palms from Palm Sunday of 2022. The person distributing the ashes will say, "Remember that you are dust and unto dust you shall return." Father Anthony Kadavil explains, "The ashes mean that we are making a commitment—that we are undertaking Lent as a season of prayer and penitence, of dying to ourselves."

During Lent, St. Charles will have rice bowls and stewardship pledge cards for almsgiving and the Lenten prayer books for prayer. There are additional Masses at 6:30 am Monday through Saturday and expanded hours for Adoration. This allows us the opportunity to spend more time in the presence of Christ in the Eucharist and turn our hearts more fervently toward God. Catholics ages 18-59 are encouraged to fast on Ash Wednesday. Catholics ages 14 and older are encouraged to abstain from eating meat. Please see our Lenten flier, website, and other media to see how you might meet, know, love, and serve Christ this Lent.

St. Charles receives 1% of the receipt totals from these receipts, and only receipts with grocery purchases are valid. **Your receipts do pay off. In 2022, St. Charles received \$792.41 from Sentry and from Piggly Wiggly \$3,325.95!** Please use the drop box located next to the Parish Office to turn them in. **Please include the whole receipt; do not cut the top or bottom off because it makes them invalid.** Do not staple, tape, roll or rubber band them together and keep them flat. Receipts expire within six months, so be sure to turn them in as soon as possible. Thank you for your help!

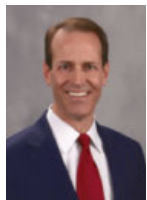
