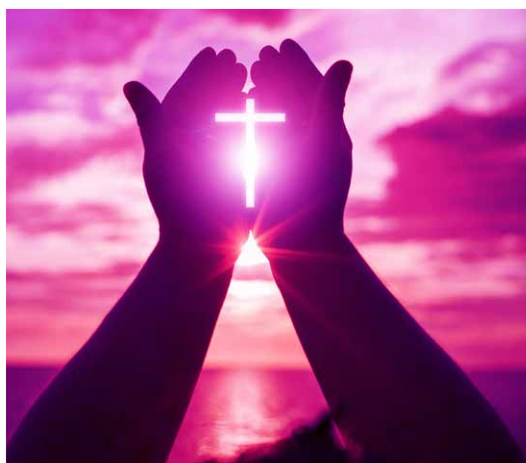

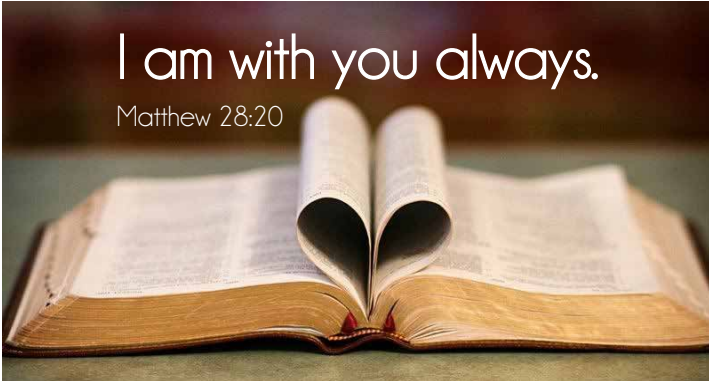

**THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION**  
**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT**

***“They saw no one else but Jesus alone”***

God cannot be contained! Think about the immensity of who God is? We speak to Him as Friend, and rightly so for He walks with us and is close to us—and He is God, the Creator of absolutely everything! He keeps us in existence because He loves us, and He chooses to use us for His Glory and our sanctification.

Brothers and sisters, as we continue on our Lenten journey, there have probably been moments in which we have slipped, maybe even fallen flat on the hopes we had set out to live through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. God is bigger than your fall. Get back up and start again.

The Lord desires to be in relationship with us—this is prayer. We can all too often become attached to the things of this world and replace God with a tangible ‘good’ before us. May I challenge you to look more deeply to the invisible for the rest of this Lenten Season and hopefully for life. What we don’t see is very real.

To help you with this challenge, the Lord has made Himself fully known through the Sacraments: visible signs of an invisible reality. Come to the Lord in the Sacrament of Confession and seek His mercy! Don’t come worried that you’re not following Lent perfectly; rather come begging the Lord to give you the grace to help you get rid of what has been placed above Him in your life and then trust that He will do it! Come with a desire to receive freedom from that which has bound you so that you can be free for deeper intimacy with God! From this restored freedom, receive Jesus’ Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Sacrament of Holy Communion. God, hidden under what looks like bread and wine, is really with us at Mass and in Adoration. We receive this greatest Gift of Love and then are sent forth—figured anew in the presence of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit present within us! We then can respond as St. Paul in second Timothy implores us to: “bear your share of hardship for the gospel with the strength that comes from God.”

**PRAY WITH SCRIPTURE**  
**Lectio Divina**

15 minutes each day spent in God’s presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

- Through her dialogue with Jesus, the Samaritan woman comes to the realization that Jesus is the Messiah. In her joy, she tells other Samaritans about her encounter with Jesus. How can you share your faith in Jesus with others?

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### Servant of God Thea Bowman

Servant of God Sister Thea Bowman was a second-generation free Black American born Bertha Bowman in Yazoo City, Mississippi in 1937. She later took the name Sister Thea when joining the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration. Being the only black woman in her order, Sister Thea committed her life to serving Black Catholics and their unique spirituality.

She held a Ph.D. in English from the Catholic University of America where she also taught, committing herself to educating others. Additionally, over the course of her life, she taught at Xavier University in New Orleans, Viterbo College in La Crosse, an elementary school in Wisconsin, and a high school in Mississippi.

Sister Thea Bowman helped shape Black Catholic identity in countless ways. She was instrumental in the 1987 publication of the first Black Catholic hymnal, "Lead Me, Guide Me: The African American Catholic Hymnal," making sure the hymnal properly showcased black spirituality and culture. She sang and recorded 25 spirituals and worship songs that were recently remastered and released on most music streaming platforms as recently as 2020!

She traveled and spoke around the world, captivating audiences with her ministry of joy. Sister Thea taught about celebrating each culture's unique differences and lifting those differences up in each culture's distinctive expression of the Christian faith.

Dying of cancer on March 30, 1990 at the age of 52, Sister Thea's legacy lives on in the more than 18 institutions named after her, her music, numerous works she authored, and countless students who received a college education thanks to the Sister Thea Bowman Black Catholic Educational Foundation. The U.S. bishops endorsed her cause for sainthood on Nov. 14, 2018. ©LPI

BECOMING FULLY CATHOLIC

On Sunday, February 19th, we celebrated the "Rite of Sending" at the 9am Mass at St. Charles Parish. This Rite sends the candidates and catechumens to be recognized by the bishop who receives them on behalf of the Church and blesses them as they prepare for full reception into the sacramental life of the Church. During the Rite of Sending, our two catechumens (Jean Rasmussen and Kylie Flores) signed the "Book of Elect" where the names of all catechumens that have gone through BFC have been added. The step is also called the enrollment of names because as a pledge of fidelity, the catechumens inscribe their names in the book that lists those who have been chosen for initiation. Then, during the Rite of Election, their names are called the same way our names are called the day of our Baptism. Thus the Church makes its "election," that is, the choice and admission of those catechumens who have the dispositions that make them fit to take part in the sacramental life of the Church at Easter.

But our parish community takes part in this step, too. As a sign of unity, our community here at St Charles made the commitment to pray for them and support them as they enter the final stages of their faith journey. Thus, they were sent forth by us and, together with Fr. Ariel, our catechumens and candidates drove to Holy Family Parish in Fond du Lac to be received by Bishop James Schuerman who blessed them and invited them to continual conversion. Please continue to pray for our catechumens (Jean Rasmussen and Kylie Flores) and candidates (Susan Keuer, Travis Selvick, Amy Voss, Jenna Nyhouse, Sarah Sigrist, and Matthew Gausman) as they prepare for full reception at Easter.
