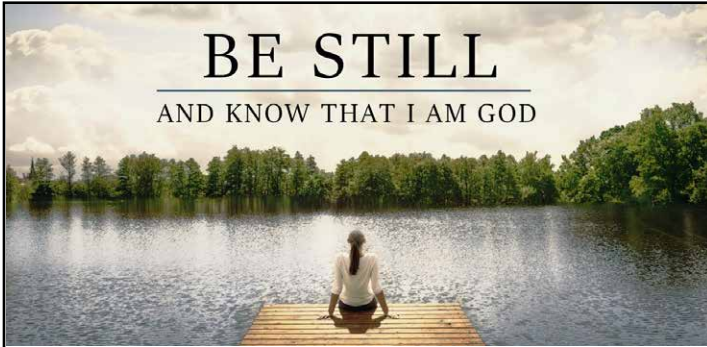

THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION
FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

“Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light.” (Ephesians 14:b)

Dearest brothers and sisters. We are in the heart of Lent, and there is more the Lord has in store for us! This should bring us joy: God is not done speaking to us, revealing to us, loving us into a deeper relationship with His Sacred Heart! We have done nothing to earn this—the Lord has invited us to respond, to be stirred up out of any complacency, so often experienced in the poverty of the cross.

“...Everything exposed by the light becomes visible...” (Ephesians 5:13). Our Lord is not afraid of our sins; if you haven’t already, please avail yourself to the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Reject any lie that stops you from believing God’s love for His beloved. Jesus died on the cross to Save you—and His Mercy is endless and everlasting! He doesn’t want you to stay in the messiness of whatever you did or didn’t do. He beckons for you to return to His Loving Gaze!

“With your rod and your staff that give me courage” (Psalm 23:4b). We can lean on Him who has shown us before (recall Exodus and the Israelites fleeing Egypt), that God spoke through Moses to part the Red Sea and all the Israelites had to do was “be still, and [trust] the Lord would fight for them.” God is parting ‘a Red Sea’ in your life. Maybe the rod hasn’t been lifted yet so all you see is the raging waters. Maybe you are on the other side, and you have witnessed the miracle of God redeeming you from that which had enslaved you. God sees you right where you are and is calling your name!

“...And smear the clay on his eyes...’ Go and wash in the Pool of Siloam... and came back able to see” (John 9:6-7). Whether you have fulfilled your Lenten practices well or feel as if you just can’t get the foundation solid under your feet, God delights that you keep trying. Hear the Lord speak these words of hope over you as He did the blind man. God is using you to show the world that He reigns; nothing is too big for Him, no one is insignificant in His Plan! Be sent and proclaim our God to a world in need of His Light shining through you!

PRAY WITH SCRIPTURE
Lectio Divina

15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

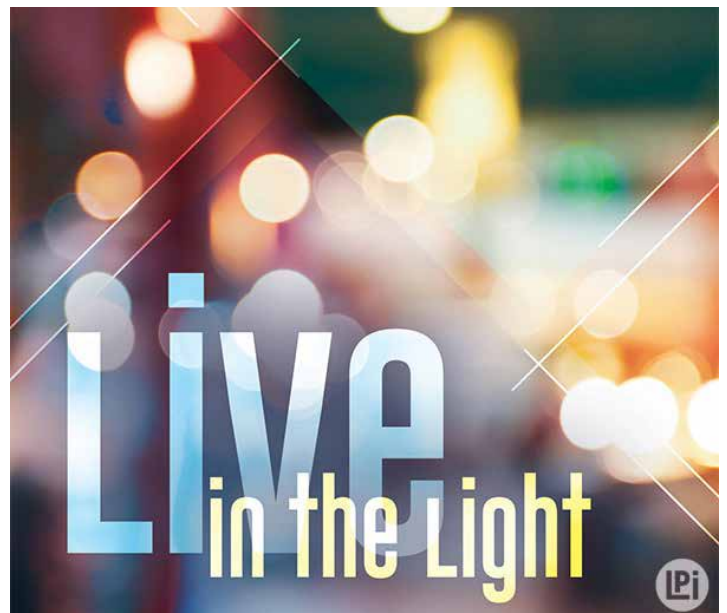
Reflection questions for Sunday, March 26th

- God revealed to the prophet Ezekiel his divine plan for the resurrection of the dead: “I (will) open your graves and make you come up out of them, my people!” As a person of faith, how does this promise give you hope?
- Paul insists that for believers, the Spirit dwelling within us gives life to our mortal bodies, raising us from the dead as Christ was raised from the dead. How does this impact your thoughts about death itself?
- In her grief and sadness at the death of her brother Lazarus, Martha professes her belief in Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of God. As the season of Lent draws to a close, in what ways have the last 40 days strengthened your faith in Jesus as our Lord and Savior?

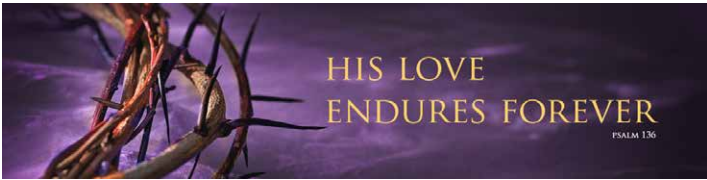

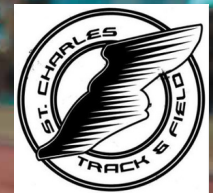

HE MADE HIS DWELLING AMONG US

The Annunciation and the Gospel of Life

The Annunciation celebrates the visit of the angel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary to inform her that she was to be the mother of Jesus. On this great feast day, we not only recall Mary's courageous "yes" to God, we also celebrate the Incarnation of Christ, our Savior. For it was there, in the womb of a woman, nine months before the celebration of the manger, that "the Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us" (John 1:14).

The celebration of the Annunciation coincides with the anniversary of the papal encyclical *Evangelium vitae* (*The Gospel of Life*). This prophetic document on the dignity and inviolability of every human life was put forth by Pope John Paul II on the Solemnity of the Annunciation in 1995. The intimate connection of these two events highlights a profound reality about the identity and value of every human person.

Luke's Gospel tells us that by the power of the Holy Spirit, Christ would be conceived within the womb of Mary. It was there, in the womb of the Blessed Mother, that Christ first took on human flesh and made his dwelling among us. Like us, the unborn child Jesus grew and developed beneath the shelter of his mother's loving heart. Through Christ's Incarnation, God chose to share fully and intimately in our humanity and bridge all distance between God and man, so that we may dwell together.

The Church teaches us that "by His incarnation the Son of God has united Himself in some fashion with every man."¹ God desired to dwell among us, as one of us, in order to bring us salvation. This truth "reveals to humanity not only the boundless love of God... but also the incomparable value of every human person."²

Each of us is made in the image and likeness of our Creator, to share in the very life of God himself. This reality "reveals the greatness and the inestimable value of human life."³ The human person is "a manifestation of God in the world, a sign of his presence, a trace of his glory."⁴ Created through the love of the Father, each one of us bears "an indelible imprint of God."⁵ By sharing in our humanity, Christ invites us to share in his divinity, that we might dwell with him for eternity.

Therefore, "the Gospel of God's love for man, the Gospel of the dignity of the person and the Gospel of life are a single and indivisible Gospel."⁶ Through Christ's descent to earth God desires to raise each one of us to the heights of heaven. May we recognize that to proclaim the Gospel of Life is to proclaim Christ, the one who *made his dwelling among us*.


