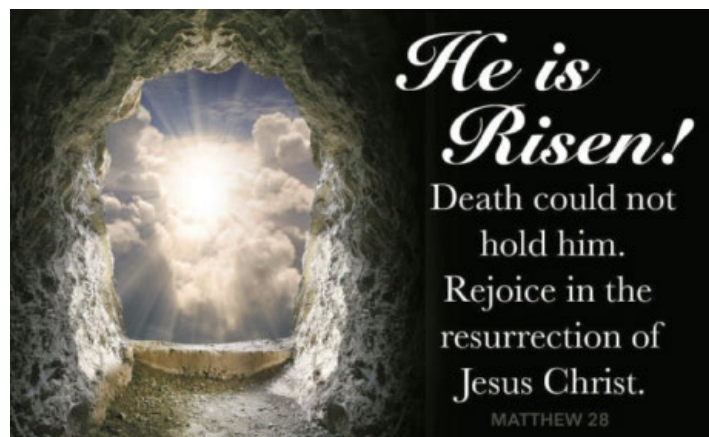

**THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION**

EASTER SUNDAY

***“When Jesus had risen, early on the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had driven seven demons.” (Mark 16:9)***

Popular Catholic piety sometimes posits that the newly risen Jesus appears first to the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is a happy thought, but it's simply not what the scriptures report. We are told quite directly that he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, “out of whom he had driven seven demons.”

Why would the gospel writer remind us of this unsavory detail of Mary's past? Historians tell us women were not qualified to give legal testimony. On top of that, to be possessed by not just one but seven demons is unsavory and terrifying. What damage had they done to her? What did she do to allow herself to be home to such evil? It doesn't seem to matter. Jesus chose Mary Magdalene to be the first one who saw him risen from the dead. He decided she was qualified.

Do you think that you are disqualified from seeing and announcing the risen Jesus because of your past demons? Maybe they are the demons of despair, confusion, self-hatred, pride, addiction, failure, boredom, laziness, or other sins. Well, don't. In the light of the Risen Jesus, all these past demons make our witness that much more believable — only if we allow ourselves to be touched by the liberating hand of Christ, just as Mary Magdalene did.

## EASTER SEASON APRIL 9TH

### He is Risen! Alleluia!!!

We have journeyed together through the forty days of Lent. We have worn purple, prayed, fasted, and given alms as we focused our hearts ever more keenly on Christ. Our music and our lives have been more sparing as we prepared our hearts for the great celebration of the Triduum and Easter Sunday.

The Easter Vigil, day three of the Triduum, is on Saturday April 8 at 8:00pm. We then celebrate our regular schedule of Sunday morning Masses on Easter Sunday. At 7:00 am, we have cantors and a string quartet. At 9:00 am, we have the Adult Choir. At 11:00 am, we have the Children's Choirs and a Brass Quartet. There is no 6:00 pm Mass on Easter Sunday. In order to help us celebrate lavishly and well, incense will be used at the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday at the 9:00 am Mass on Easter Sunday.

Of note this year is that we will be welcoming many new members into the church who have participated in Becoming Fully Catholic with Father Ariel. At the Easter Vigil, we have the honor of welcoming two Catechumens, who will receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. On Easter Sunday morning, five Candidates will be confirmed in the Catholic faith.

Easter Sunday is the start of the Easter Season, which lasts for fifty days, culminating in the Feast of Pentecost. During the Easter Season, the entire character of our worship changes. Our music becomes brighter and more jubilant. We can proclaim once again the joyous refrain of "Alleluia." "Alleluia" comes from the ancient Hebrew meaning, "Praise the Lord!" It is used in the Mass as a superlative expression of thanksgiving, joy, and triumph since Christ has conquered death. We sing "Jesus Christ is Risen Today" with its chorus of Alleluias. We proclaim the Gospel Acclamation, which uses Alleluia as the refrain and then a verse that summarizes the main idea of the upcoming Gospel reading. Lastly, we are dismissed at the end of the Mass with the priest or deacon chanting: "Go in the peace of Christ, Alleluia, Alleluia!" To which we respond, "Thanks be to God, Alleluia, Alleluia!" This ancient chant ties us to our rich tradition and history as Catholics and reminds us every week of Christ's resurrection and triumph over death. He is risen: Alleluia!



## DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY APRIL 16TH

### What is Divine Mercy Sunday?

Since the year 2000, the Second Sunday of Easter is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. This celebration finds its roots in the private revelations of a Polish nun, Faustina Kowalska, who lived in the early part of the twentieth century.

Sr. Faustina, though poorly educated, kept a diary during her short lifetime in which she documented her experiences of visions and conversations with Jesus. In her diary, Sr. Faustina wrote that she experienced an image of the Risen Lord, from whose heart two rays shone, one red (representing blood) and the other white or translucent (symbolizing water) with the words "Jesus, I trust in you" at the bottom. Sr. Faustina claimed that Jesus told her, "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish."

The Image of Divine Mercy is very familiar to Catholics. It symbolizes God's abundant mercy. Sr. Faustina's diary stresses the importance of God's mercy and our need to be open and accepting of that mercy. According to Sr. Faustina, it was Jesus' own wish that a Feast of Mercy be established on the Second Sunday of Easter, to "be a refuge and shelter for all souls ..."

Sr. Faustina died in 1938 and was canonized by Pope John Paul II in 2000. It was John Paul II who proclaimed during her canonization ceremony that the Second Sunday of Easter would also be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Devotion to the Divine Mercy has grown rapidly over the past twenty years, and there are many devotional practices including a novena, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, the Hour of Great Mercy (traditionally celebrated at 3 p.m.), and a plenary indulgence granted to those who receive the Eucharist and celebrate reconciliation on Divine Mercy Sunday.

Here at St. Charles, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy is prayed every Friday at 3:00 p.m. in the Chapel at the end of Eucharistic Adoration. On Sunday, April 16th, there will be a Divine Mercy Service from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. This service will include Eucharistic Adoration, veneration of the Image of Divine Mercy, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and the opportunity for individual confession. All are welcome to come and pray with us.

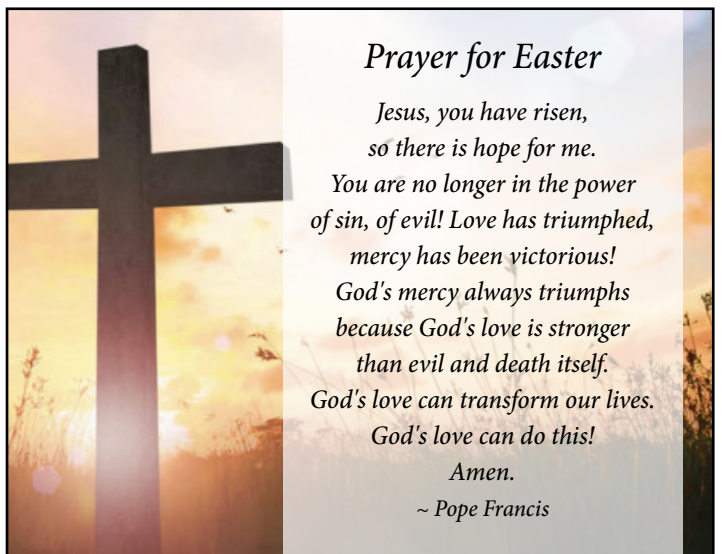
