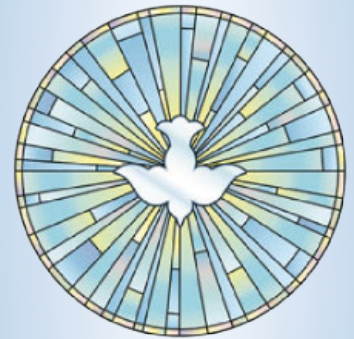

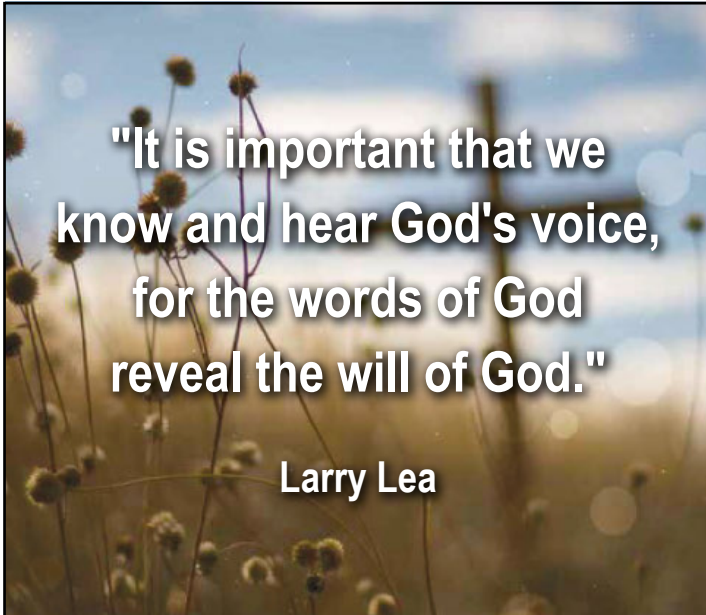

**THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION**  
4TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

I recently rescued a dog. She's a terrier and rather adorable. And she's crazy about me. She could spend all day with me. But I'm a pastor at a parish, and sometimes I leave her at the front desk of the church office. She constantly amazes me by her ability to distinguish between my voice and that of everyone else. If I say one word, even if I'm hidden around a corner, she'll sprint toward me and jump up into my arms.

This week the readings focus our attention to the voice of the risen Jesus Christ. Comparing his disciples to sheep and himself to a shepherd, he says, "They recognize his voice." He speaks to us and wants us to respond. When we hear his voice, we follow. Throughout this coming week, we will experience many interior promptings to receive God's love and to love Him in return. That's his voice. Follow it into the safe and tender arms of Christ.

By contrast, some voices we will hear do not convey God's concern and love for us but rather produce fear, despair, and other harmful mischief. Jesus calls these voices those of robbers. Does an idea or thought make it harder for you to love God? If so, run away. Let it go. It is most likely not the voice of the Risen Lord. Keep waiting for him to speak. You will recognize his voice. Then run to him as fast as you can.

**FOCUS**

(FELLOWSHIP OF CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY STUDENTS)

I have been a missionary for three years at Troy University, and I have never seen growth like we are having now! After one week of recruiting students to join us in St. Louis for our annual conference next January, we have already surpassed our previous year's registration. This is happening from our students buying into a life full of relationships with each other and with God. While here, I have noticed a poverty of friendship, and we have needed to embrace the model of discipleship taught in Acts 2:42 to show them what abundant life is.

I am excited by how my team and students have concluded this year. They are embracing the vision of missionary discipleship and are being generous in inviting others into their relationship with Jesus each day. Recently in my Bible study, a freshman named Brent asked me why we have had so many converts, and I was able to tell him with confidence, that in my three years in Troy, we have seen 13 students convert to the faith, and only two of those students were introduced to Jesus and His Church through a missionary. The other 11 were all pursued by their peers on campus, and I am pictured above with two men who joined the Church last Easter for this exact reason! This is the vision that we are striving to build on campus... where the baptized live their vocation to holiness through "prayer, fellowship, the breaking of the bread (the sacraments), and the teaching of the apostles." (Acts 2:42)

Please pray for depth in our mission! More specifically, please pray that the Holy Spirit may awaken our younger students that they may be convicted of their identity in Jesus more deeply and then live a life of mission out of that identity.
