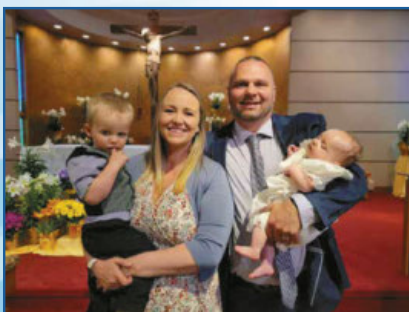

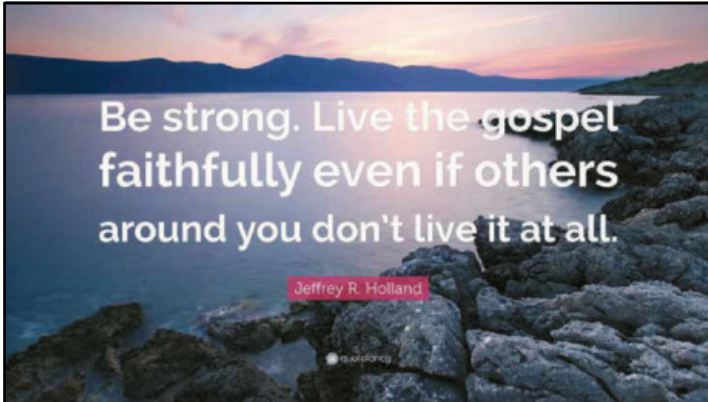

THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

"I am the Way, the Truth and the Life"

Today, we hear the call of the first Deacons and the role they offer in service to the Church. There is a line that always strikes my heart in the Ordination Mass for a Transitional Deacon, those men who God-willing will be called to be ordained priests of Jesus Christ the following year. "Receive the Gospel of Christ whose herald you have become. Believe what you read, teach what you believe, and practice what you teach."

Part of their service to the Church as Deacon is that they can proclaim and preach the Gospel at Mass [along with assisting at the Altar, baptizing and officiating at weddings]. We don't want this plea of the Church to just remain with the ministerial priesthood. At our baptism, all are given the three-fold gift of being named priest, prophet, and king. We call this the common priesthood as it is shared by all. From this outpouring of the Spirit on our lives, we too must live the lines spoken to Transitional Deacons! We live as resurrected people who know that the cross of Christ is not a stumbling block. Rather, it is the cornerstone on which we can ground our very lives! This is what it means to receive, believe, teach, and practice—we know the person of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, and proclaim our nothingness without Him!

When God revealed Himself to Moses, He gave the name I AM. Jesus throughout the Gospels has several I AM statements, revealing intimately Who He is for them, for us! As the second person of the Trinity, Jesus is both distinct and united in the Father and Spirit as He speaks these truths. As we prepare for Pentecost, let us be renewed that this same Holy Spirit reveals to us the challenge and invitation to receive more deeply from the well-spring of Trinitarian Love (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit). With every Sign of the Cross as we begin a prayer, bless ourselves, our food, our children, our living space, let us live as Easter people, called out from the grave and into the light of hope! "Do not let your hearts be troubled..."

Lectio Divina

15 minutes each day spent in God's presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

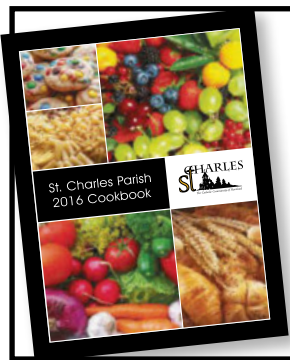

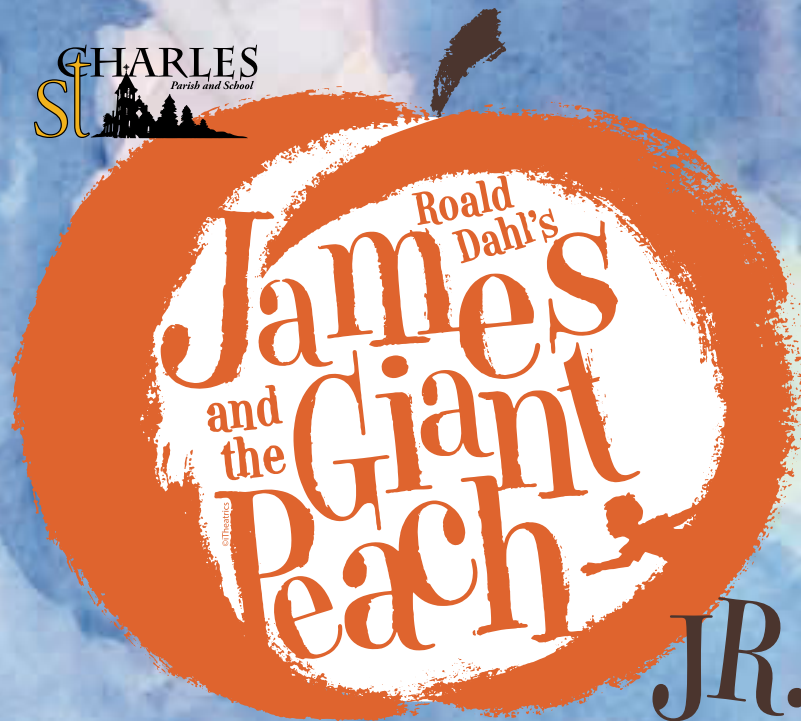
SAFE ENVIRONMENT NIGHT EVENT
