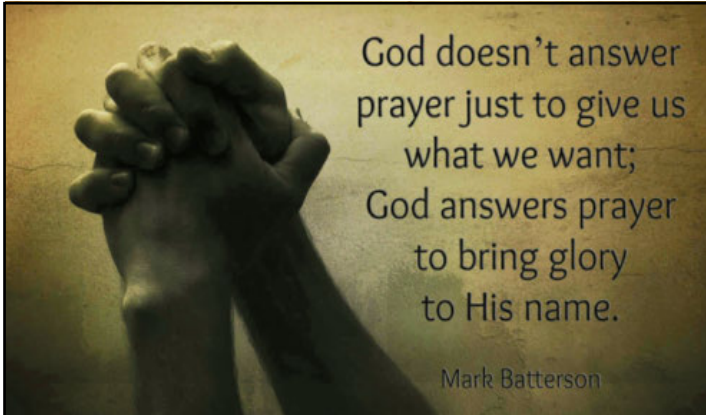

THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

***“And behold, I am with you always,
until the end of the age”***

Today, we celebrate the Ascension of our Lord into Heaven. Jesus left us clear instructions that I repeat here from the Acts of the Apostles, as they are meant for us who too should ‘act’ as His ‘disciples’ – “...wait for ‘the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak’ ...It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in [Hartland]...” What resonates in your heart as you hear Jesus speak these words to you today?

There might be prayers that you have given to Jesus that you think He should have already answered by now, and instead He speaks words of ‘waiting.’ We are asked to actively wait with perseverance and hope, confident that the Lord will make all things known and clear in His timing. How does that hit you? We don’t have to know the time or season [though we desperately want to], and this should free us to a deeper trust that the One who loves us wholly is providing even unbeknownst to us!

Rest in confidence that at your Baptism, you received the same Spirit that descended upon Jesus, Mary, and every Apostle at Pentecost. By ourselves, we can do nothing. With the Power given to us, refreshed and strengthened in us both through Sacraments and through our own relationship with God, we must live as a witness of the Resurrected Jesus. Jesus suffered and died; we may witness this same sorrow and loss in our own trials. Jesus rose from the dead and performed miracles before and after, and we witness this too in the wonder moments of our days. May the witness of our lives be that in which our hearts are conformed to His so as to live as our Maker and so join Him in the suffering, death, and resurrection!

15 minutes each day spent in God’s presence – reading, reflecting, responding and resting with his Word – adds up to 90 hours in one year. That is time well spent and a testimony to how a little at a time turns into something remarkable!

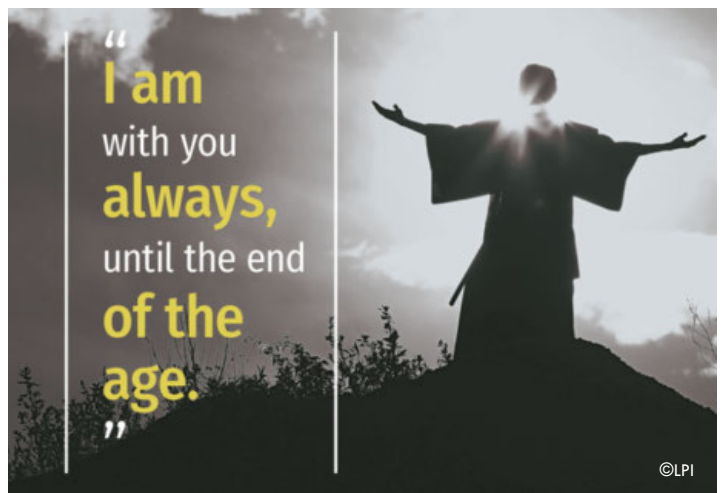
Reflection questions for Sunday, May 28th

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI ADORATION

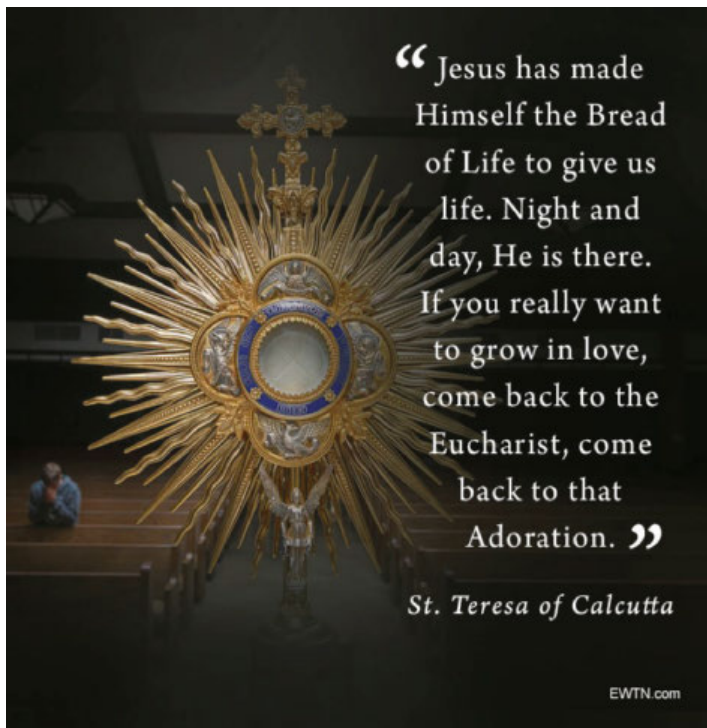

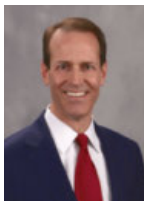
