THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION
16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Life, like the church, is often burdened with evil, smallness, and impurities. The Lord's parables give us a hope-filled perspective on all three.

Evil: In Jesus' parable about the good farmer whose enemy plants weeds at night, Jesus tells us that God is not the cause of evil but permits evil to exist with good out of his patient love. He will finally deal with it, but his love lets things stay messy for a time.

Smallness: It's funny that Jesus says his kingdom looks like ... wait for it ... a bush. What a letdown! Yet this little shrub still somehow has room for all the birds of the sky. The smallness of the Church, and even our own little lives, still provides plenty of room for all whom God sends.

Impurities: Divisions and hypocrisies in the Church and our own hearts exasperate us. Recall that Jesus compares his kingdom to a lump of dough with impure leaven eating away at it and therefore making it expand. It's the secret of the Cross. Not how we'd prefer it. But finally, great news.

The field, the bush, the loaf: All three parables invite us to embrace a patience rooted in hope: one day the field will be weeded, the bush filled with birds, and the risen loaf leaven-free.

RETURN TO THE CUP

We are often asked when will we return to the cup at Mass. As you may already know, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee has granted permission for the distribution of the Precious Blood of Christ to be brought back to Mass. The Archdiocese has also instructed pastors and parish administrators to catechize, form, and carefully instruct their parishioners on the distribution of the precious Blood. For example, one of the points that seems to bring confusion is whether one receives more graces or more of Jesus by receiving under both species. On this point, the Church states that Christ is “truly, really, and substantially contained in Holy Communion. His presence is not momentary nor simply signified, but wholly and permanently real under each of the consecrated species of bread and wine” (Cf. Council of Trent, Session xiii (October 11, 1551), *Decretum de ss. Eucharistiae sacramento*, cap. IV, *De transubstantione*). Therefore, it is not necessary to receive both species to receive Christ fully. Although receiving under both species is a “fuller sign” that manifests more visibly Jesus’ command to “eat” and “drink,” receiving under one kind only is receiving both His Body and Blood. There is a lot more to discuss on this topic, hence the need to catechize.

We have discussed and considered catechesis prior to bringing back the distribution of precious Blood during Sunday Masses. One of our considerations is that, as priests, we are entrusted with protecting and promoting the dignity and reverence of the Eucharist. After careful consideration, we have decided that we will wait until we move to the new church to begin catechesis and eventually distribution under both species. This includes re-training our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, ushers, and much more.

We wish to be transparent about our decision, and we want to share a couple of points behind our reasoning. One is that we will be moving to our new church soon. Thus, training our ministers for the distribution of the precious Blood will mean to re-configure several things for a few months. We would then have to do it again once we move into the new church. The most important reason behind our decision is reverence to the Eucharist. As you know, our current church has carpeting. As we considered bringing the cup back, we saw a potential for spill incidents. When that happens, Jesus’ Most Precious Blood will remain on the carpet regardless of our effort to clean it and will most likely be walked over. Fortunately, that won’t be an issue in our new church since it will be tiled.

We are grateful for your patience and understanding, and please know that we also look forward to bringing the cup back. Until then, we will continue to distribute communion under the Body only.
