THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Once I gave my three-year-old niece a certain toy for Christmas. When she opened it, she was happy. Shortly thereafter, her five-year old sister opened another present from me: the same toy along with some play jewelry. The three-year-old cried out “That’s not fair! Why’d she get the jewelry, too?!”

Let’s face it: there’s something about God’s grace in our religion which bugs us. We love to look at others’ blessings and cry out: “That’s not fair!” Catholicism is not fair in the sense that it is a religion founded on God’s grace which is unmerited favor. God pours his mercy, love, and divine life upon us not because we’re good but because He is infinitely good.

If you think the “not fair” quality of grace is easy to accept, consider how typically angry we get when we hear the parable of the workers who get paid way more than they deserve. The hyper-generous landowner says to the indignant hard workers, “Are you envious because I am generous?” Well, yes, they are, and so are we! Therefore, we have to reckon with this painful truth in order to move into the divine sphere of gifts, which is the world of Christ and his Church. Then we are able to move beyond a tit-for-tat world and into one where gifts are poured forth on those who don’t deserve it — namely, upon us.

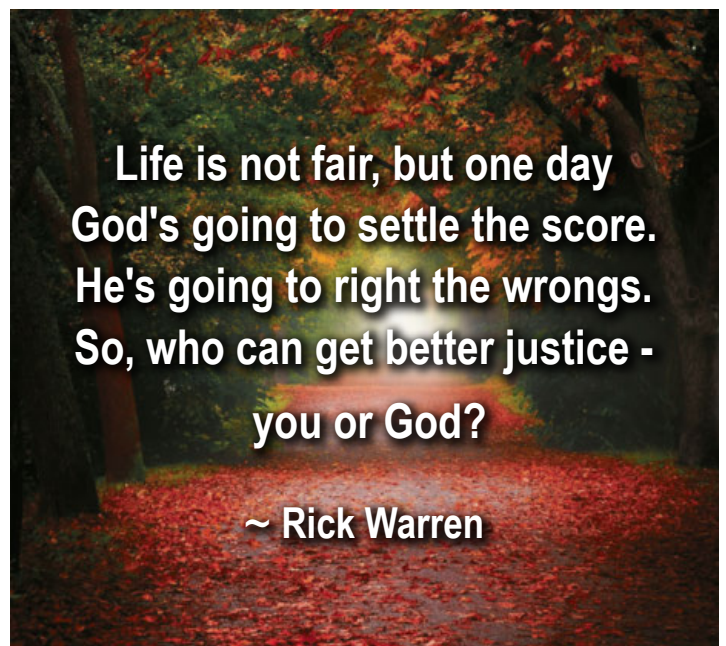
Reflection questions for Sunday, October 1st

St. Charles Adoration Speaker Series

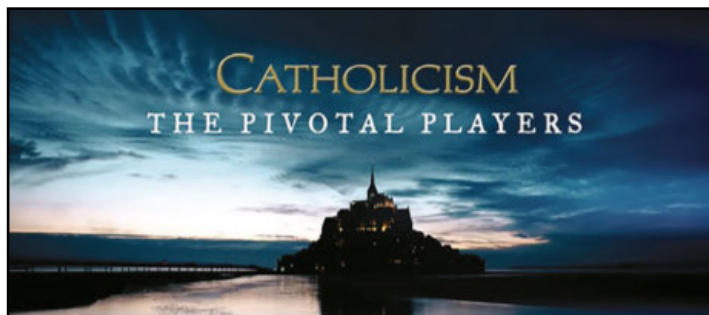

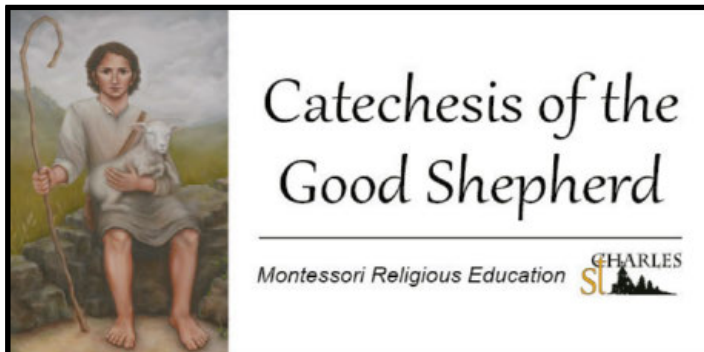


PET BLESSING

Bringing our children to Mass

We would all love to see our children fully engaged during Mass. As parents, we know that while they might not look fully engaged, children are often watching, listening, and absorbing. More is going on inside of them than we can see. How about experiencing Mass with your child/ren in a new way? See the Mass through their eyes... as you walk into the church and throughout the Mass.

1-3 year-olds

They may notice the overall beauty through praying, standing, kneeling, sitting, and going to receive communion. You may comment on what you see: “We all sit,” “Now we pray.” Keeping it simple, without expecting a response, focuses them on what they are absorbing and experiencing.

6-8 year-olds

Observe them from time to time. Notice when they seem most focused, remembering each child’s different ways of attention and that moving bodies can help to keep ears listening. After the Mass, you might wonder with them about a part you saw them noticing: “I wonder what that meant?” or “I wonder why the priest did that?” Again, a response is not necessary. If they offer one, follow their lead. Wondering with them is powerful - it allows them to engage in their own profound encounter with God.

Child/ren are great imitators. Model for them both in action during Mass and in your own wondering questions after. Maybe seeing through their eyes will bring a part of the Mass to you in a new and profound way.

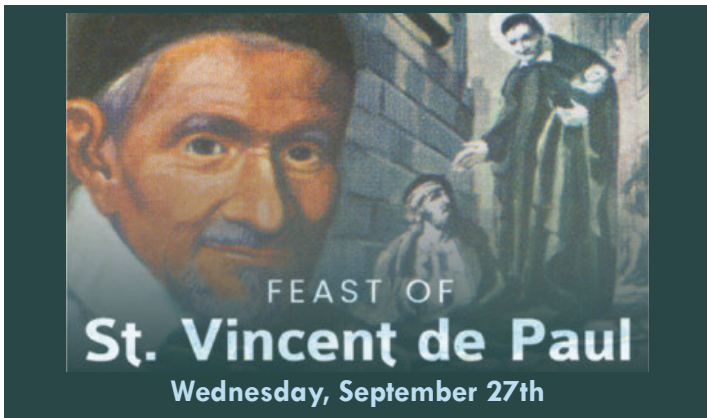

2023 CIRCLE OF LOVE

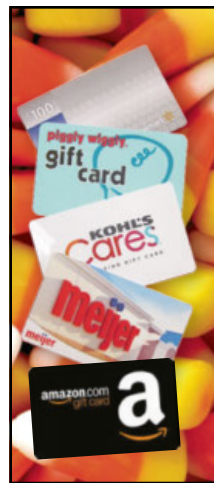
