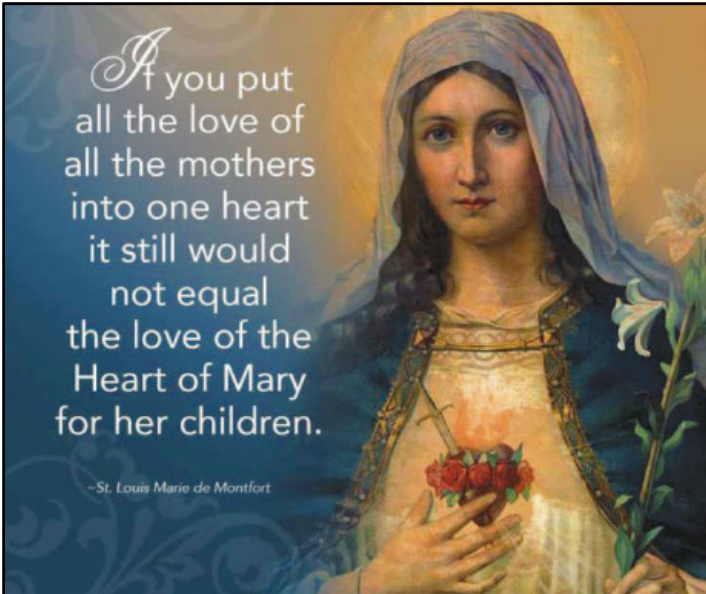

ALLOW MARY TO BE THE GUIDE FOR THE NEW YEAR

I invite you, whether for the first time or as a regular thought, into the beautiful journey at the beginning of this new year with a Mom who is with you unconditionally! In years when January 1st is on a weekday, the Church would celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary as a Holy Day of Obligation. We do so this year, too, as EVERY Sunday is a Holy Day of Obligation!

“And Mary kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart.” Brothers and Sisters, our Blessed Mother loves us each as Her children. She delights to hear our voice, to hold us close to Her Heart (and that of Her Son’s Sacred Heart). Through the lens of Her Pure Heart, may we have the courage to reflect on them from Her eyes.

Mary doesn’t look at the past year, month, week, day, or hour and cast judgment upon what we did not get accomplished or how what was accomplished doesn’t uphold a certain standard of expectation. Our Blessed Mother generously and with such care looks at the lives we have lived and celebrates our perseverance! We stayed the course! We probably deviated from the plan a few times—She sees the poverty in which we leaned into the Truths of our faith; our faults do not worry Her.

As 2023 begins, let us turn to the gaze of Mary, our Mother! She walks with us, She guides us, She leads us to Her Son and to Her Spouse, the Holy Spirit. Whatever last year brought, whatever this year will bring, we can have the confidence that together with Mary, all things are being held close to the Hearts of Love!

Reflection questions for Sunday, January 8th

- Nearly five hundred years before the birth of Jesus, the prophet Isaiah foresaw a time when all the nations of the world would see the glory of the Lord shining upon the people of Israel. How do you think the birth of Jesus reveals to the world the glory of God?
- Paul wrote of the “mystery” that was revealed to him, namely, the Gentiles and the Jews (all believers) were “coheirs” and “copartners,” equal members in the body of Christ. How can we celebrate this wonderful message of inclusivity with others?
- Matthew includes the story of the visit of the magi to teach us how the birth of Jesus fulfills the prophecies of Isaiah (first reading) and the prophecies of Micah (Mi 5:1), the prophetic text that Matthew quotes. Who are some people today you think need to hear about Jesus?

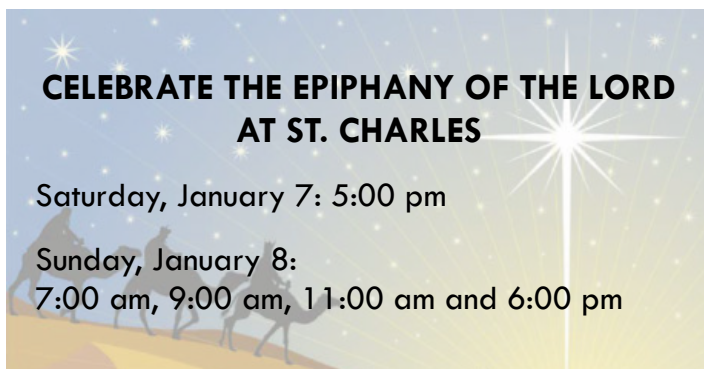

Are you or anyone you know missing any of the sacraments of initiation? Our Becoming Fully Catholic (BFC) formation is continuing this winter. Becoming Fully Catholic is a journey for those who desire to be fully integrated into the life of the Church through the sacraments of Baptism, Communion and/or Confirmation. The Church envisions that every journey of faith is accompanied by a personal encounter with Christ. As such, Becoming Fully Catholic seeks to facilitate this “encounter” through formation and experience.

Our formation is designed to provide an immersion into the Church’s life of faith through Her beauty, goodness, and truth. Put simply, BFC is not a class or a program, so to speak, but a journey of faith whereby candidates will learn about and experience the Church’s tradition through conferences, witness talks, visits to architecturally-inspiring churches, and awe-provoking ministries.

To do this, BFC consists of gathering together as a group on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month from 10:15-11:45 at the Parish and one-on-one mentorship on alternating weeks, which will take place at a time convenient to the candidate and mentor. 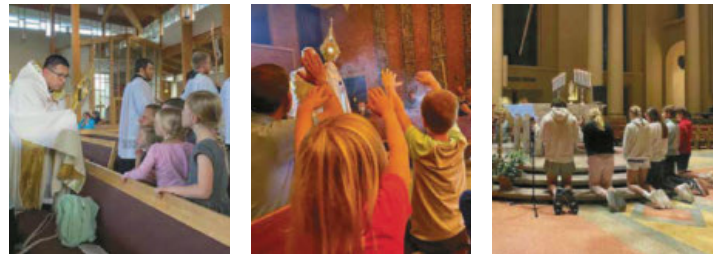

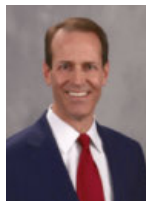
