THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Our culture seems more polarized and divided than ever. In this wounded situation, our Catholic faith has a healing remedy to offer: the gift of wisdom. When the Lord offers to give King Solomon anything the monarch desires, he requests "an understanding heart" (1 Kings 3:9). The King doesn't ask for power to defeat his enemies. He asks for a wise and understanding heart to judge right from wrong. This wisdom is elevated and fulfilled in Jesus, who teaches us to bring forth "both the new and the old" (Matthew 13:52).

In our fractured society, we Christians should stop pining for political power to crush our perceived enemies. That often just makes things worse. Rather, it's much more useful to beg for the grace of true wisdom, which transcends both sides of the aisle. This places us in a fresh position from which we can help our culture see what is true and good all across the ideological spectrum. Because this wisdom is free from ideological narrowness, it will help to heal these painful fractures. Lord Jesus, this week, pour into us your healing wisdom.

TESTIMONIAL BY PARISHIONER CHAD AMBROZIAK

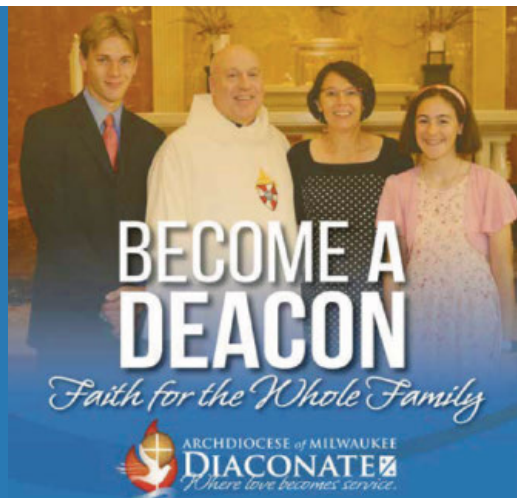
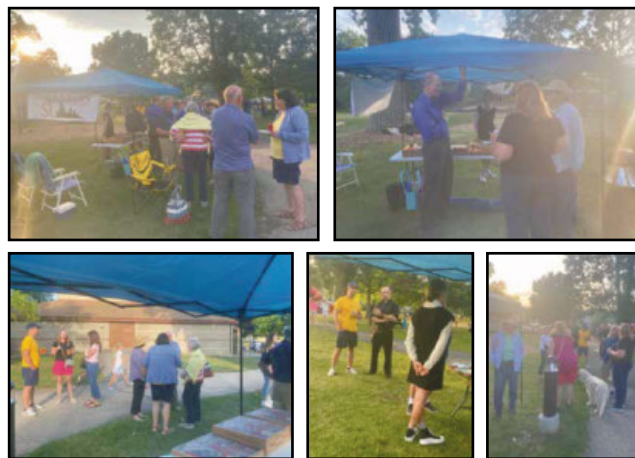
Why did you decide to join Becoming Fully Catholic (BFC)?

I always had faith, but my faith wasn't formally nurtured in my youth. After my daughter was born, I felt this longing for more and realized I needed more than just faith. I went from church to church, denomination to denomination. Something was missing, and I was never fully satisfied, so we decided to finally give the Catholic Church a shot. Attending Becoming Fully Catholic was a game changer for me. I never fully understood the foundation of my Christian faith until I fully embraced the Catholic Church and the Becoming Fully Catholic process. Learning about the history and founding of the Church and about apostolic tradition tracing back to Jesus Christ himself was the selling point. For the first time in my life, I felt a desire to explore my faith. The Church has helped me stay accountable to myself and to God. I cannot be the man I need to be, the husband I need to be or the father I need to be, without embracing the fact that I need God. I need His help and guidance, and the Catholic Church has helped me in that pursuit. I never felt as close to God as I do now until I started Becoming Fully Catholic and embracing the Catholic Church. The Church will always be the conduit to help keep me longing for and embracing God.

This process has changed my life, but Becoming Fully Catholic was just the beginning, though. I'll never feel "fully" Catholic as this is a lifelong journey for me. This process opened the door, but it's now up to me to continue my journey and take responsibility for my faith. Read scripture, pray more, educate and guide my family and look for ways to discuss my faith with others. Most importantly, I'm right where I'm supposed to be. I'm a husband, I'm a father, and I'm Catholic. Becoming Fully Catholic brought me home.

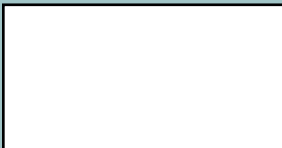
